

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Recycling at the curb is easy. Our co-mingled program includes a 96 gallon container to collect recyclables. Recycling containers are serviced every other week and costs \$5.70/month. Acceptable materials include cardboard, pressboard, cartons, jugs, plastic bottles, tin and aluminum can. Glass is NOT accepted in the curbside program. Residents can sign up by calling 942-7700.



Recycling containers are collected every other week on the same day as garbage service. Print the annual [Collection Calendar](#) as a helpful reminder. Please place containers at the curb on the regular collection day by 6am for service to avoid call back fees. Additional containers are available for an extra \$2.00 per month, with a one year commitment. Request by calling 942-7700.

Garbage is not allowed in the recycling container. Repeat offenders are charged a garbage disposal fee of \$8.15.

DROP BOX RECYCLING

There are seven drop box locations around Richland for residents to drop off recycling. These location are for approved materials only and do not accept garbage or hazardous waste. Clayton Ward Recycling services and monitors these locations. Drop-box recycling includes cardboard, newspaper, tin, aluminum, glass, plastic beverage containers and scrap paper, like phone books, pressboard boxes and junk mail.
