

LANDFILL

Richland residents may dispose of self-hauled waste at the resident rate with proof of current Richland refuse service. Residents must bring their current utility bill and identification to receive the resident rate. Richland residents must be present to receive the resident rate. Exceptions require prior approval from the Solid Waste manager. All other customers will be charged in accordance with current [published rates](#).
