

Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program 2021 - 2026

Compliance with State Law

RCW 35.77.010

- * State Law requires that the legislative body of each city and town, pursuant to one or more public hearings thereon, shall prepare and adopt a comprehensive transportation program for the ensuing six calendar years.

Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program

- * State-wide coordinated financial planning document for transportation system improvements
 - * Coordinated between local agencies (Cities, Counties, Transit agencies), regional planning organizations (MPO's, RTPO's) and Washington State Department of Transportation
- * Queues up transportation system improvements that may be funded in the coming six-year planning horizon
 - * Higher priority, fully or partially funded projects listed in early years, lower priority unfunded projects listed toward the end of the six-year period

Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program

- * The Transportation Improvement Program is not:
 - * A commitment to construct a project
 - * A statement that planning and design is complete
 - * A map with specific alignments
 - * In Richland, staff have used a TIP map over the years to provide a visual representation of the general area and connectivity of projects listed in the TIP

- * Fully or Partially Funded Priority Projects
 - * SR240/Aaron Interchange – ***Partially funded***
 - * South GWW Intersection – ***Partially Funded***
 - * Vantage Hwy Pathway Ph 2 – ***Partially Funded***
 - * Van Giesen/Thayer Intersection- ***Funded***
 - * Center Parkway North Extension – ***Partially Funded***
 - * Steptoe/Tapteal Intersection Design – ***Partially Funded***
 - * Steptoe/Gage Intersection (partnership) – ***Funded***

2021 – 2026 TIP

- * Unfunded Priority Projects
 - * Downtown Connectivity Improvements
 - * Center Parkway South Extension
 - * Street Light Retrofit
 - * Island View to Vista Field Trail

2021 – 2026 TIP

- * Projects added since last year
 - * Downtown Connectivity Improvements
 - * GWW Pedestrian Crossing at Newton
 - * Jadwin Pedestrian Crossing at Catskill
 - * Jadwin Bike Lanes
 - * Street Light Retrofit

2021 – 2026 TIP

- * Projects removed since last year
(Fully funded and advanced in 2020)
 - * Duportail Bridge – Phase II
 - * Columbia Park Trail East
 - * Traffic Signal Systemic Safety
 - * Duportail/Queensgate Intersection Improvements
 - * Duportail/Keene Intersection Improvements
 - * Island View to Vista Field Trail “Study”

Recommendation to Council

Request that the Planning Commission and the Parks and Recreation Commission recommend the City Council adopt the 2021 – 2026 Six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
