

ORDINANCE NO. 11-20

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2020 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the City's Industrial Development Fund, Park Reserve Fund and Broadband Fund, and declaring that a public emergency exists in certain funds.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2019, Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 55-18 approving the 2020 Budget; and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated in the Industrial Development Fund for maintenance of surplus city-owned land, separation of irrigation and lighting on city-owned land, extension of fiber infrastructure along Kingsgate Way, or real estate consulting costs; and

WHEREAS, sufficient unappropriated funds are available in the Industrial Development Fund and the Park Reserve Fund to support the required budget adjustment; and

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2020, a public hearing was held pursuant to RCW 35.33.091 regarding the proposed increase in appropriations from beginning fund balance in the Industrial Development Fund and Park Reserve Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Facts Constituting Emergency. The expenses contained within this ordinance were not anticipated when the 2020 Budget was approved.

Section 2. Declaration of Public Emergency. Due to circumstances described above, Richland City Council declares that a public emergency exists in the Industrial Development Fund and Park Reserve Fund.

Section 3. Amendment of the 2020 Budget. The 2020 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the Industrial Development Fund, Park Reserve Fund, and Broadband Fund from the identified sources as follows:

**Industrial Development Fund**

Current Appropriation:	\$ 5,100,735	
Increase in Appropriation:	\$ 300,000	Source: Unappropriated Fund Balance
Increase in Appropriation:	\$ 11,200	Source: Interfund Transfers
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$ 5,411,935</u>	

**Park Reserve Fund**

Current Appropriation: \$ 997,361  
Increase in Appropriation: \$ 11,200 Source: Unappropriated Fund Balance  
Amended Appropriation: \$ 1,008,561

**Broadband Fund**

Current Appropriation: \$ 637,089  
Increase in Appropriation: \$ 90,000 Source: Interfund Transfers  
Amended Appropriation: \$ 727,089

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.

Section 5. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
