## FALL CLEANUP BEGINS OCTOBER 30

The annual Fall Cleanup will provide residents with pickup of bagged and bundled organics, extra bags of garbage, and small items at the curb. This year the annual cleanup will begin on October 30 and run each week through the end of the December. Pickups will occur on your regularly scheduled day, except holidays.

### - EXTENDED GREEN WASTE PICKUP -

Yard waste collection in the green cans will continue every other week through the winter months except when we are experiencing temperatures below freezing. Prohibited wastes in the green can still apply. No garbage, bagged green waste, pet waste, dirt, rock, concrete, metal or treated wood

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### How often may I utilize curbside pickup?

Every week, beginning October 30 through December, on your regularly scheduled pickup day.

### What items cannot be picked up at the curb?

The following items will not be picked up at the curb:

- Paints, chemicals or other hazardous waste
- Large appliances
- Tires
- Furniture or bulky items larger than 2'x4' or weighing more than 50 lbs.
- Dry wall or other construction or demolition debris
- Rocks, bricks, dirt, or concrete

### Do I have to bundle branches and limbs?

Yes. Tie branches, limbs and large sticks in bundles no longer than 4 feet in length. Individual branches should not be more than 4 inches in diameter. Larger branches and tree trunks can be taken to the landfill. Residents, with proof of garbage service, get unlimited free yard waste dumps at the landfill year round.

### What if my regular garbage day falls on a holiday?

If your regular garbage day falls on a holiday, we will collect your fall cleanup items the following week, on your regularly scheduled collection day. Garbage trucks will not pick up fall cleanup on holidays. Regular garbage routes will still run on holidays, with the exception of Christmas day. Garbage routes will be delayed by one day during Christmas week and will run from December 26 through December 30.
