

ORDINANCE NO. 42-18

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2018 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the City's Community Development Block Grant, HOME, Streets Capital Construction and Parks Project Construction Funds from HUD grant awards.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2017, the Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 49-17 adopting the 2018 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 budget included estimates of the CDBG and HOME grant awards to be received; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2018, the U.S. Department of HUD notified the City of the actual 2018 grant award amounts for CDBG of \$306,966 and HOME of \$698,293; and

WHEREAS, insufficient funds were appropriated in the Streets Capital Construction, Parks Project Construction, CDBG Fund and HOME Funds to complete the projects approved with the 2018 grant awards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of the 2018 Budget. The 2018 Budget is hereby amended to provide for additional appropriations in the following funds from CDBG and HOME grant funding:

Community Development Block Grant Fund

Current Appropriation: \$ 727,802
Increase in Appropriation: 51,766
Amended Appropriation: \$ 779,568

HOME Fund

Current Appropriation: \$ 1,466,096
Increase in Appropriation: 224,393
Amended Appropriation: \$ 1,690,489

Streets Capital Construction Fund

Current Appropriation: \$30,978,695
Increase in Appropriation: 127,650
Amended Appropriation: \$31,106,345

Parks Project Construction Fund


Current Appropriation: \$ 4,607,304
Increase in Appropriation: 75,000
Amended Appropriation: \$ 4,682,304

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
