

ORDINANCE NO. 50-18

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2018 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the Streets Capital Construction Fund and the Industrial Development Fund, declaring that a public emergency exists in the Industrial Development Fund, and amending the 2018-2023 Capital Improvement Plan.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2017, the Richland City Council passed Ordinance No. 49-17 approving the 2018 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 – 2023 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) includes the Swift Boulevard Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2018, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 38-18 increasing the budget for the Swift Boulevard Improvements project to address changes in project scope and funding; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2018, the City opened a single bid for the Swift Boulevard Improvements project, with an estimate that far exceeded the available funding; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2018, City Council adopted Resolution No. 113-18, rejecting the July 10, 2018 bid and directing staff to revisit the project scope and budget in preparation for a second bid; and

WHEREAS, staff completed the work directed by City Council and opened bids on September 24, 2018 for a revised scope of work; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is required to support the redefined scope of work; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2018, a duly advertised public hearing was held pursuant to RCW 35.33.091 regarding the increase in appropriations from beginning fund balance in the Industrial Development Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Facts Constituting Emergency. The expenses contained within this ordinance were not anticipated when the 2018 budget was approved.

Section 2. Declaration of Public Emergency. Due to circumstances described above, the City Council declares that a public emergency exists in the Industrial Development Fund.

Section 3. Amendment of the 2018 Budget. The 2018 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the Industrial Development Fund from existing fund balance, and in the Streets Capital Construction Fund from a transfer out of the Industrial Development Fund as follows:

Street Capital Construction Fund

Current Appropriation: \$ 31,106,345
Increase in Appropriation: \$ 835,000
Amended Appropriation: \$ 31,941,345

Industrial Development Fund

Current Appropriation: \$ 3,291,975
Increase in Appropriation: \$ 835,000
Amended Appropriation: \$ 4,126,975

Section 4. The City of Richland's 2018 – 2023 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is amended to reflect the budget adjustments contained herein.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.


