

ORDINANCE NO. 61-18

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2018 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the City's Streets Capital Construction Fund.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2017, the Richland City Council passed Ordinance No. 49-17 approving the 2018 Budget; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2018, Council adopted Resolution No. 67-18, authorizing staff to submit an application to the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC) for a grant to improve safety for elementary and middle school walking routes; and

WHEREAS, a \$57,096 WTSC grant was awarded, and agreements authorizing the grant funds and matching funds from the Richland School District in the amount of \$28,606 were executed; and

WHEREAS, as the approved 2018 Streets Capital Construction Fund did not include funding for the Richland School Crossing Improvement Project, a 2018 budget amendment is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of the 2018 Budget. The 2018 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the Streets Capital Construction Fund for the Richland School Crossings Improvement Project as follows:

Streets Capital Construction

Current Appropriation:	\$ 31,941,345
Increase in Appropriation:	<u>\$ 85,702</u>
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$ 32,027,047</u>

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
