

ORDINANCE NO. 37-19

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2019 Budget in the City's General Fund and the General Government Construction Fund to appropriate new revenue received from *Atomic Frontier Day 2019* sponsorships and rural county capital funds.

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2018, the Richland City Council passed Ordinance No. 60-18 approving the 2019 Budget; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Ordinance No. 37-19 addresses two amendments to the 2019 Budget, the first being the receipt of additional funds associated with *Atomic Frontier Day 2019*; and

WHEREAS, the Richland community has hosted events celebrating its heritage associated with the Manhattan Project; and

WHEREAS, between 1948 and 1961, the community hosted several multi-day events and programming under the name *Atomic Frontier Days*; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richland recognizes 2019 as the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Manhattan Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richland is honoring the Manhattan Project's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary by partnering with organizations, agencies and community groups to present a festival and parade on Saturday, September 14, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the festival and parade will be called *Atomic Frontier Day 2019*; and

WHEREAS, *Atomic Frontier Day 2019* is supported by generous community sponsors with contributions totaling \$29,700; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to formally thank its sponsors and appropriate the sponsorship dollars into the project budget; and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated in the General Fund for the *Atomic Frontier Day 2019* special event; and

WHEREAS, the second adjustment to the 2019 Budget concerns the acceptance of unanticipated rural county capital funds from Benton County to be used for demolition of the former City Hall facility; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2019, Richland City Council adopted Ordinance No. 34-19, amending the General Government Construction Fund in the amount of \$308,000 to be received from the Benton County Rural County Capital Fund; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2019, Richland City Council adopted Resolution No. 105-19, authorizing a disbursement agreement with Benton County for receipt of rural county capital funds in the amount of \$350,000; and

WHEREAS, the actual grant award of \$350,000 from Benton County exceeds the estimated grant award of \$308,000 by \$42,000; and

WHEREAS, the City must appropriate the additional unanticipated \$42,000 so it can be expended on demolition of the former City Hall facility as agreed to between Benton County and the City of Richland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of the 2019 Budget. The 2019 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the General Fund from sponsorship dollars, and the General Government Construction Fund from rural county capital funds as follows:

General Fund:

Current Appropriation:	\$ 60,244,923
Increase in Appropriation:	\$ 29,700
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$ 60,274,623</u>

General Government Construction Fund

Current Appropriation	\$ 5,557,311
Increase in Appropriation:	\$ 42,000
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$ 5,599,311</u>

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
